VisionQuesT Contemporary photography as the final exhibition for this season, will present "Other Places" by Mario Daniele and Marco Maria Zanin. The two artists are connected to the theme of the landscape and both, with different techniques and content, deal with this "historical" subject of Photography in a particular and innovative way, breaking conventions, digging beyond what we see and allowing us to enter places where the landscape continues beyond the edges of the photograph

Mario Daniele with "Quel sentiero per il lago" (That path to the lake) leads us straight away to an open space, a vastness not precisely measurable, where man feels nature's eternal potential. It is an almost invisible path, more existential than physical, that leads to a place subjectively implied and not a place per se. We observe small portions of earth washed by great lakes, where we as spectators are confronted by our gaze, where the subject is not the individual, nor the lake, the person or the earth, but their relationship.

Marco Maria Zanin develops his research project "Sicily" in the analysis and comparison between two poles: on the one hand that which belongs to the world of the beginnings and the other the phenomena of superstructures in the contemporary age. As an old emigrant, in search of sensations felt by generations who left Veneto region searching for fortune, Zanin first leaves for Brazil, then he decides, accepting a proposal and at the same time a challenge, to shift his attention to the south. He crosses the sea and leaves for Sicily where he creates this body of work, once again addressing the story of a hard rural land, where he finds the same themes and the same elements that have always characterized his research.

Both artists suggest that it does not matter where these places are, because they are everywhere, in and out, archetypes of a possible spiritual landscape, landmarks in an "atlas of emotions", they are indeed "other places".

Biographies

Mario Daniele,

In 2006 he begins his researchon the theme of landscape. In 2008, with the series Océan, dedicated to the Atlantic coast of France, receives the first prize at LuccaPhotoFest; in conjunction with same festival, the series is exhibited at Palazzo Guinigi (Lucca). In 2010, during the SI Fest in Savignano, his work Winter, done between the snowy hills of the Langhe, is seen and appreciated by the Collector Fabio Castelli. From that meeting he was invited to participate, the following year, in the first edition of MIA Fair (Milan Image Art Fair) of which Castelli is the founder and artistic director. The research on the landscape continues with "That path to the lake",a poetic investigation on alpine lakes and mountains, presented at MIA Fair 2013. In parallel, from 2010 he continues to work on the "Museums" series, dedicated to moments of the life in museum spaces. his work is represented by several galleries in Italy and abroad. He has participated in numerous exhibitions of art and photography, including The Others in Turin, MIA Fair in Milan, Art Verona, Off-Contemporary Art Fair in Brussels, and CatLog Fotofever in Paris

Marco Maria Zanin

Born in Padua in October 1983. Eclectic humanist, he graduated first in Literature, Philosophy and International Relations and later with a master's degree in psychology. Simultaneously he developed his artistic activity, and makes many trips and stays in different parts of the world, putting into practice that displacement' exercise essential for the critical analysis of social contexts, and to nourish his research aimed at identifying spaces common of the human community. Myth and archetype as undelying matrices for contemporary behavior, are at the center of his investigation, which works on the observation of the relationship between man, the land and the weather. He chooses as a privileged instrument, photography, which he often mixes with different techniques thus overcoming the boundaries of other artistic disciplines, such as installations and sculpture. He Lives and works in Padova and San Paulo Brasil.
